Guide to Using Social Media for Dudley LAC

- Before you set up your profile discuss with your carer and social worker the risks and benefits of using social media.
- Make sure you know how to use the privacy settings and set your profile to private or friends only wherever possible.
- Make sure you know what to do if something goes 'wrong'.
- Keep your personal information private.
- Never share your password with anyone else.
- Only add friends you know in real life.
- Use a nickname that doesn't identify your location or age.
- Alter your pictures and videos before you post them to remove information which could identify where you live, go to school etc.
- Profile and photo share only with people on your friends list.
- Think about the possible consequences of the information and photos you post.
- Never post nude or revealing photos or selfies this could be illegal.
- Don't post your plans or whereabouts on your site.
- Ignore and block rude or offensive comments posted on your profile –
 BUT report them if they are repeated, upsetting or if you think they could be bullying or are illegal.
- Contact the site administrator if someone creates a social networking page in your name and tell your carer and/or social worker.
- Never meet in person with anyone you first met online.
